



**99.3 THE FOX AND MUSIC BC PRESENT  
"VANCOUVER SEEDS 2008"  
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**HOW TO ENTER:**

1. **Fill out an entry form**, available at 99.3 The Fox Radio or at Music BC#501 - 23 W Pender St Vancouver, BC V6B 1R3 ([www.musicbc.org](http://www.musicbc.org)). You can also download the entry form from CFOX.com and fill it out. Submit all entries along with 3 recorded samples of the artist's/band's work (on CD or jump drive only) as well as a bio, photo and any publicity material you choose, to: **Vancouver Seeds 2008 Suite 2000 – 700 West Georgia St. Vancouver, BC V7Y 1K9**

2. No purchase necessary. All entries must be received by 5pm (PST), Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup> 2008.

3. This competition is open to residents of BC, except the employees, directors, and immediate family members of CFOX Radio, Corus Entertainment Inc., Long & McQuade Musical Instruments, Labatt Brewery and Music BC, their employees, and immediate family members of anyone in these groups.

4. Artists or bands with a release currently signed to or distributed by a major label are not eligible. Any variations on this rule will be decided by the contest officials, and those decisions are final.

5. All entries, including CDs, and publicity material, become property of 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 and will not be returned. No responsibility will be taken for entries lost, misdirected, misplaced, or delayed for any reason whatsoever.

**THE CONTEST:**

6. Entries will be judged by 99.3 the Fox programming staff and designated members of the Canadian Recording Industry. When called for listeners of 99.3 The Fox will be able to vote on selections of music and their votes will be tallied and decided upon by 99.3 The Fox designated judges.

7. All decisions of the judges and contest officials are final.

8. If any of the bands or artists scheduled to appear on the Vancouver Seeds 2008 CD/Download change personnel make musical changes to such an extent that the contest officials deem that the band or artist no longer fairly represents their entry submission, they may not be included on the 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 CD/Download.

9. All artists and bands which will appear on the 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 CD/Download will be required to sign a waiver form regarding mechanical royalties, which

will be waived since the Seeds CDs are sold only to raise money for charitable purposes or given away free. No profits are recovered from the sale of 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008.

10. All winners must acknowledge the rights of CFOX Radio, Corus Entertainment Inc., Long & McQuade Musical Instruments, Labatt Brewery and Music B.C. to broadcast or print the winners' names and music, without direct compensation other than the prizes awarded.

11. All winners (bands and artists) chosen to be on the 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 CD/Download agree that they can not execute any promotion or publicity (concerts, appearances, interviews) with any other radio station in the British Columbia market for a period of 1 Year (365 days) from the time the project is pressed and made available without expressed written consent from 99.3 The Fox. The FOX reserves the right to have full exclusivity on the bands that we market as 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 winners.

12. 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 Winners will be required to perform at a minimum of four 99.3 The FOX Showcases (date and venue TBD) over 12 months after the release of the 99.3 The Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 CD at no charge.

13. All winners must be available to perform at an official Fox Vancouver Seeds 2008 release party during date and venue TBD.

14. All members in bands chosen to take part in The 2008 Fox Vancouver Seeds project must be 19 years of age (legal Drinking age) or older by Friday May 16<sup>th</sup> 2008 (contest closing date)

15. Each of the 5 chosen 2008 Fox Vancouver Seeds Bands will receive prizing in the form of: Protocols MBox system and \$500 credit per band with Long & McQuade.

16. Each of the 5 "runner up bands" – (those taking part in the final round showcase at The Roxy, but not chosen as a winner of 2007 Fox Vancouver Seeds) will receive a \$50 Gift Certificate to Long and McQuade per band

17. The contest is subject to all Canadian provincial, federal & municipal laws & regulations.

18. No purchase of any product including Long & McQuade and Labatt Brewery is required for entry to this contest

19.
